2024 Budget Approved:

- **1. Small Increase:** The 2024 budget has a small increase of approximately 3% for each owner in comparison to the 2023 payments. This adjustment aims to ensure that the HOA can continue to meet the needs of our community effectively.
- 2. Increased Costs for Insurance and Adding Roof Cleaning: Two items contributed to a significant increase in our total expenses. Our insurance costs have been increased by \$15300 (53%) over the 2023 budget. The budget also includes added costs for a reserve fund to pay for our next roof cleaning.
- **3. Fine-Tuning Processes:** Thanks to the collaborative efforts of Ed Lynch and Terry Keene, the approved 2024 budget reflects a fine-tuned and strategic approach to financial planning. They conducted a thorough examination of our reserves and expenses. The adjustments made based on their analysis ensure that our community remains financially stable while continuing to provide the high standards we all value.
